OCI MEMBERSHIP POLICY DOCUMENT

INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP

Revised Policy as on 16th May 2024

- 1. Indian optometrist who has completed 4 years (3+1-year compulsory internship) Bachelors in optometry or equivalent in India can apply for membership under OCI
- 2. Indian optometrist who has completed 10+2 with science followed by 2 years of diploma in optometry/ophthalmic techniques/ophthalmic assistant or any similar nomenclature in India can apply for membership under OCI.
- 3. Candidates who have graduated with Bachelors in optometry or equivalent through distance education mode before 31st December 2010 can apply for membership under OCI
- 4. OCI will offer membership to those individuals, who have completed degree through lateralentry as per UGC norms.
- 5. Indian optometrist practicing/living abroad who have completed a 4-year degreecourse in India can apply for membership under OCI
- 6. Foreign national optometrists educated in an Indian university can apply for membership under OCI
- 7. Foreign national optometrists educated outside India, will be considered for OCI membership depending on which university they graduated and membership of respective professional body.
- 8. Optometry students can apply for student membership from first year of optometry. Post completion of degree and submission of degree certificate, students will be issued professional membership
